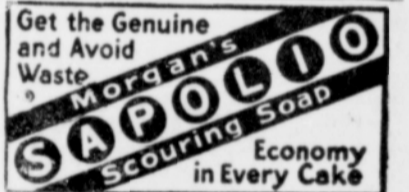

whose deposits have already reached \$600,000. At the present rate of increase Gresham will soon have a million-dollar bank."

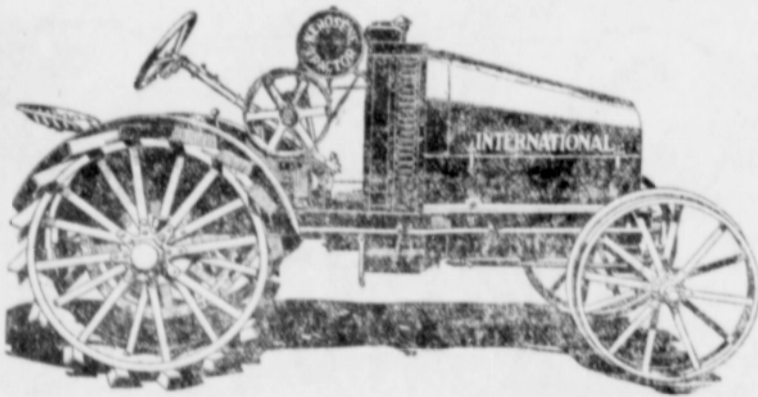
