RESULTS OF ELECTION.

A number of inquiries have come to this office regarding the vote on various county offices especially that of county superintendent.

The official count for precinct 309 1/2 was Alderson 60, Burton 44; precinct 309 Alderson 42, Burton 41; precinct 308 Alderson 68, Burton 59.

This gave Mr. Alderson a lead of 29 in these three precincts which include the town of Gresham and quite an additional territory surrounding.

In precinct 311 it was reported that there were 98 votes cast, 90 for Burton and eight for Alderson. The vote in the other precincts was not learned.

The vote for president was as follows: Wood 166, Lowden 118, Johnson 66, Hoover 23 and Poindexter 1.

The vote for county commissioner was as follows: Muck 92, Rudeen 53, Thomas 49, Kelly 47, Wheeler 37.

The race for district attorney in these precincts was rather close 159 votes being cast for Evans and 137 for Myers.

In the race for judge of district court, Department No. 1, Bell won a combined vote of 88 in the Gresham precincts; Alexander with 67 votes and Mears with 27 came next.

For judge of Department No. 2, Deleh led with a total vote of 153 while McDougal and Jones had 43 and 37 respectively.

Hawkins with 163 votes led in the race for judge of Department No. 3. Kauffman received 114 votes.

Kanzler as judge of the Court of Domestic Relations won a sweeping victory. He had 238 votes as against Nielsen's 22 votes.

All of the measure received good majorities in the three precincts.
