While there is a shortage of gasoline there is apparently no shortage of tires judging from the tire ads in the Outlook and other papers.

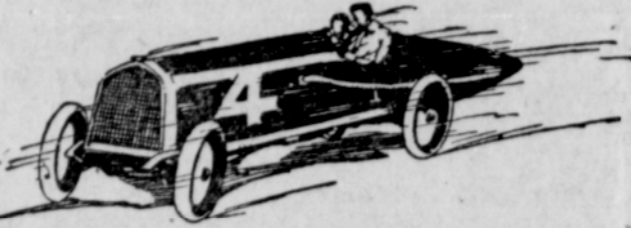
