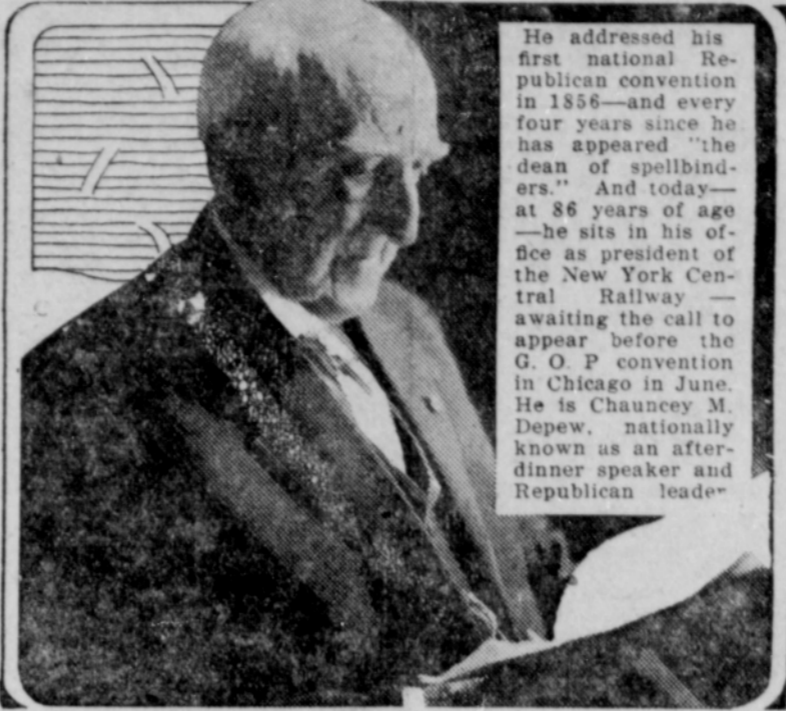


FIREMEN'S CANDIDATE LEADS QUEEN CONTEST
