The reception to the public school teachers which was announced for the evening of October 12 at the Methodist church has been postponed until a later date which will be announced.

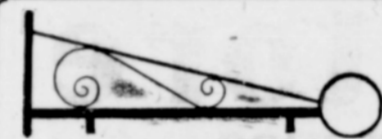
Arthur Regner, of Portland, was in Gresham today looking after business matters. He has recently remodeled and repaired his residence on Second street making it an attractive and modern home.

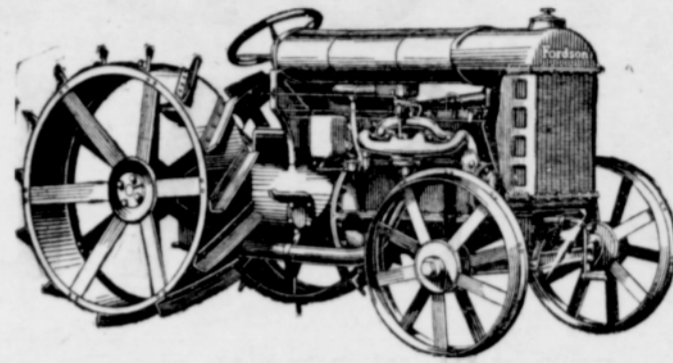

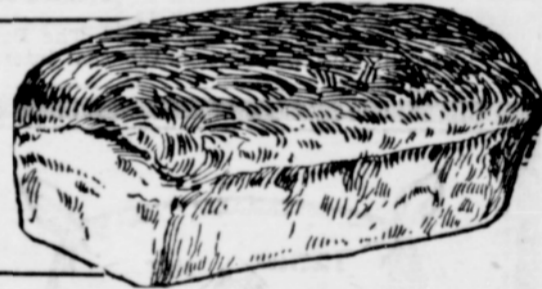

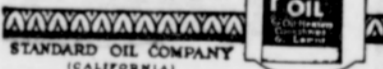

Marines Lose Popular Soldier.
First Sergeant Dan Daly, undoubtedly the best known man in all the services with the exception of Sergeant York of Argonne fame, was placed on the inactive list of the Marine Corps Reserve recently. Daly won two medals of honor for valor in the Boxer rebellion and in the capture of Fort Riviere in Haiti, and is said to be the only man in all the services who holds two medals of honor. In the World War his feats of exceptional bravery won for him the Medaille Militaire and the Croix de Guerre from France, and the Distinguished Service Cross from General Pershing. His passing from the active list to accept a position with a prominent banking house here removes from the marines their most picturesque of the old school soldiers.
