LEGISLATIVE SESSION PASSES RESOLUTIONS

Resolutions of appreciation of the work of S. Benson and confidence in the highway commission were passed during the closing sessions of the recent legislature.

Senate concurrent resolution No. 17 gives evidence of appreciation of the efficient, faithful services rendered the state by S. Benson in the developing of the highway program in Oregon.

Resolved, The thirty-first legislative assembly of the state of Oregon hereby tenders its thanks and appreciation to the Hon. Simon Benson for the able, zealous and highly successful performance of his duties as a member of the state highway commission of the state of Oregon from the inception of said commission to the date of his retirement from said office; and be it

Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be engrossed and signed by the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives and presented to the Hon. Simon Benson, as a testimonial of the appreciation of the legislative assembly for the services well and faithfully performed for the benefit of the state of Oregon.

The other bill Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 19 expresses the confidence of the legislative assembly in the highway commission. This resolution was introduced by the committee on Raods and Highways and reads as follows:

Whereas the highway program of the state of Oregon is the largest single enterprise in which the state of Oregon is engaged; and

Whereas the state highway commission has, through its integrity and ability, carried forward said program in a manner which has inspired the confidence of the people of the state of Oregon; and

Whereas the gratitude of the people of the state is the only reward which the members of said commission will receive for their services, which have been rendered without pecuniary compensation; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the senate of the state of Oregon, the house of representatives concurring:

That the people of the state of Oregon, through their representatives, express to the highway commission their full confidence in and approval of the acts of the commission, as well as appreciation of services rendered.

Local readers will be interested in learning that Senate Bill 342 relating to the salary of justice of peace of Multnomah precinct, Multnomah county, has been signed by Governor Olcott.

House Bill 371 which provides for appropriating money for conduct of The Cedars has been signed by the governor.

Another bill of interest to local dairymen especially, is Senate Bill 191 which provides for the registration of dairy bulls. This also has been signed by the governor.

SENATOR McNARY WINS LARGER APPROPRIATIONS

Through the insistent efforts of Senator McNary, half a million dollars was added to the appropriation in the agricultural bill for forest fire protection. The bill originally carried \$125,000 for this purpose but the senator convinced the senate that this amount was totally inadequate and won in the contest with the economists on the floor of the senate.

The senate also passed Senator McNary's bill, authorizing the secretary of war to grant right of way over government land to the state of Oregon for the Columbia river highway. It also passed a bill introduced by Senator McNary securing rights of way and easements over public land in connection with a number of federal irrigation projects in Oregon.
