SEWER SYSTEM NEEDED. Gresham has needed a sewer system for a long time and daily the need becomes more urgent.

It is almost unthinkable that a city the size of this, with a densely populated central portion, covering approximately 25 ordinary blocks, with well settled outlying districts, has all the improvements, conveniences and attractions of a thriving community—but is sewerless.

City water system, electric lights, city gas, paved streets, cement sidewalks, public library, splendid schools, fine business blocks, beautiful residences—but no sewer.

So far resort has been had to individual septic tanks, some of which are poorly constructed, over crowded and inoperative and become merely stinking cesspools, offensive and dangerous to health.

The overflow of some of these so-called septic tanks empties into the gutter and is very objectionable.

All for the want of suitable sewer drainage for the city.

It is time for the citizens to wake up to the need and adopt a plan which will meet present urgent necessities and permit extensions as needed in outlying districts.

It presents a difficult problem. That is probably why nothing has so far been done. But the most difficult problem is the unconcern of some of the property owners or their opposition to any proposed plan. But it is bound to come and the reasonable thing is to adopt the most feasible plan and all pull together to accomplish the necessary thing.

The council is taking up the matter and there is reason to believe the councilmen understand the situation well enough to not merely talk about it but bring something to pass with reasonable speed.

President Harding Sets Example in Economy. Thrift has perched above the White House door.

Until President and Mrs. Harding moved into the White House it has always been the practice of the House Appropriations committee to provide for the purchase of furniture for the private apartments of the President and his family.
