In a recent advertising campaign of the nationally known tire company, Gresham was listed among the towns having only 455 cars. These figures were obtained in a check of the automobile records. The officials explained to the Outlook representative that the present campaign was limited to papers in towns having 600 cars registered.

Feeling sure that the field covered by the Outlook was not covered in this count a check was made in this office of cars owned by people whose addresses were Gresham, Portland Route A (now Troutdale Route 2), Fairview, Troutdale, Corbett, Latourell, Bull Run, Eagle Creek and Boring. In the 61,545 cars in the 1921 automobile record there were 1038 names registered under these various addresses.

More than 30,000 cars have been registered that have not yet been published in the lists. If there is the same proportion belonging to this territory in this 30,000 as there were in the first 60,000 the total registration here would run about 1500.
