PASSING THROUGH THE FIRE.

The railway and the railway employees are having quite a set-to over the matter of reduction of wages now on hearing before the railway labor board.

The railroad labor board has no jurisdiction in such matters, it is claimed by the railroads, as the Interstate Commerce Commission is the only federal body having authority only to fix reason-

able rates and working conditions.

Answering the charges made by W. Jett Lauck, an employe of the railroad labor unions to the labor board that large amounts of money are being wasted in the financial and operating management of the railroads, presidents of a number of the leading railroad lines, presented a joint statement on behalf of the western railroads, to the railroad labor board in the hearings in the case involving reductions in wages.

The railroads protest against the labor board continuing to allow the hearings before it to be made a means of spreading propaganda.

The public is vitally interested in the outcome of these hearings. The railroads are passing through the fire, as it were, and their future efficiency and growth depends upon a re-adjustment of rates which involves possibly a re-adjustment of wages.
