Mr. Edison's test questions and the failure of college trained young men to answer them satisfactorily to Mr. Edison has set the country to thinking.

Mr. Edison is both right and wrong. A college young man is lacking in many things but he has gained a great deal that gives him an advantage over the untrained youth.

A college education never was intended to make it possible for one to answer all the technical questions that the scientist or the specialist in any line might ask.

"Oh, I have read but I can't remember." "I know but I can't think just now." These are common expressions that mean a lamentable confession of failure.

A high school or a college training means primarily that one starts life as a student but one must keep it up, outside of the schoolrooms, in order to enjoy the permanent benefits.

Or look at the facts as to men in public life. Less than one per cent of American men are college graduates. Yet out of this one per cent have come:

- 55 per cent of our Presidents. 38 per cent of the Members of Congress. 47 per cent of the Speakers of the House. 62 per cent of the Vice-Presidents. 62 per cent of the Secretaries of State. 50 per cent of the Secretaries of Treasury. 69 per cent of the Justices of the Supreme Court.
