He thought it was safe so went ahead,
An instant more the fireman was dead.

The great engines met with a mighty crash,
E'er either could signal and avoid the smash,
While masses of iron and wood fell around
And human bodies were dashed to the ground.

Men rushed to the scene with hands outstretched,
Cool water from the stream they fetched,
But Carl, the fireman, had breathed his last,
His spirit to his God had passed.

OREGON PRUNES FIND MARKET IN ENGLAND

Another car of prunes from the Oregon Growers Cooperative association has started from Salem on a trip to England, making the second within a week and the 29th since last fall when the first "Mistland" prunes went to the merric isles.

Prunes are in season all the year around on the English table for many of our common fruits can be grown successfully only under glass and the prices for peaches and grapes grown in such a manner are extremely high.

Peaches sometimes sell in English markets for an amount equaling 25 cents each due to their scarcity and the expense involved in producing them.

LEGIONNAIRES WILL VISIT OLD WORLD

Two hundred and fifty members of The American Legion will sail for France August 3d, to attend the dedication of the Flirey monument and to participate in a series of ceremonies arranged in honor of the French government. The Flirey monument is a tribute to the valor of the American troops.

The cost including steamship transportation both ways, special trains, automobiles, hotels, meals, sight-seeing, tips, etc., will not exceed \$775 per person. This is from New York. The American Legion will have National Commander, John G. Emery in the party.

The Legion will go to the Pyrenees to visit the birthplace of Marshal Foch. At Blois the Legionnaires will be present at the dedication of the statue of Joan of Arc presented to the city by the Joan of Arc committee of New York. At Rheims the veterans will participate in the presentation of a 3,000,000-franc gift to the city library by President Nicholas Murray Butler of Columbia University on behalf of the Carnegie Foundation.

Paris, Toulouse, Bordeaux, Lyon, Strasbourg and Metz will officially receive the veterans, but one of the most unique receptions will be at St. Die, a battle-scarred town near the old Luneville front. In this historic place stands the house in which the Alsatian monk, Wladsee-Muller, lived when he wrote the document suggesting that the western continent be named for the navigator Amerigo Vespucci.

The delegation will be headed by Franklin D'Olier, former national

commander of the American Legion. The members of the party will represent according to membership present every state and every branch of the former fighting forces of the United States. Each state being represented, giving the state of Oregon four.

The party will return to the United States, September 10th.
