THE FINANCIAL PROBLEM.
How the fair board will come out financially will not be known for several days after the close of the fair. The Outlook hopes to publish the financial statement as soon as available. The indications are that with record attendance today and tomorrow the receipts will cover the expenses and possibly more.
The fair this year started with a big handicap. Rains discouraged many last Sunday and Monday, Monday and Tuesday were wet days and a wet day hurts a county fair where so much is out of doors.

The failure of lights for two nights in the middle of the week resulted in a heavy financial loss. This loss will only be offset in small part by increased attendance the last three days and nights.
There is every indication that people both of the country districts and of the city are desirous that the debts should be wiped out, the grounds and buildings improved and the county fair continue at this location with all the assurances of success.

FORMER GRESHAM MAN DEAD FROM ACCIDENT

Word has been received today of the death last night in a Klamath Falls hospital of E. J. Heselstine of Merrill, Oregon, former resident of this community and proprietor of a 12-mile store. Death was due to an accident which occurred a week ago when Mr. Heselstine slipped from a grain stack and fell onto a broken pitchfork handle which penetrated his body for several inches. Blood poisoning resulted.
Mr. Heselstine came here with his family from Wisconsin several years ago and went to the Klamath Falls country about three years ago. He was 39 years of age. He leaves a widow, who is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. R. W. Calkins of Gresham, and four young children.
The body will be brought here for burial but the funeral arrangements have not yet been made.
