"Taxed to Death and Damn Near Ruined."

Business men who are squirming under taxation burdens will read with keen interest the following letter sent to an English bank by one of its customers, explaining why he was unable to reduce his overdraft. It was embodied in an address by Harry Coe, vice president of the Anglo and London Paris National Bank, San Francisco. Here is the letter:

"Dear Sir: For the following reasons I regret being unable to reduce my overdraft. I have been help up, held down, sandbagged, walked on, sat upon, flattened out and squeezed by our income tax, the super tax, the excess profits tax, war loans, war bonds, war savings certificates, the automobile tax, and by every society and organization that the mind of man can invent to extract what I may or may not have in my possession.

"The government has governed my business so that I do not know who owns it. I am inspected, suspected, examined and re-examined, informed, required and commanded, so that I don't know who I am, or why I am here at all.

"All that I know is that I am supposed to be an inexhaustible supply of money for every known need, desire or hope of the human race, and because I will not sell all I have and go out and beg, borrow or steal money to give away, I am cursed, discussed, boycotted, talked to, talked about, lied about and held up, hung up, robbed and damn near ruined, and the only reason why I am clinging to life now is to see what will happen next."

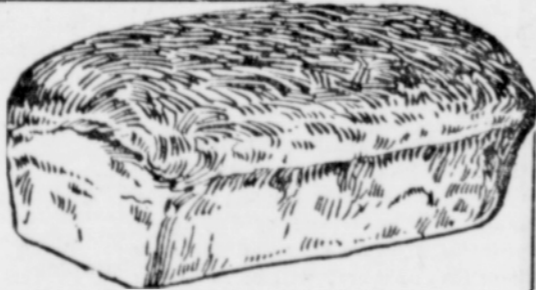
