CHAMBER PLANS DEVELOPMENT.

January 5th has been selected as the date of the annual meeting of the Oregon State Chamber of Commerce, according to announcement by state chamber officials today.

The outstanding feature of the annual meeting will be consideration of the state-wide development program proposed by the Oregon Development Board.

While this \$300,000 development fund will be raised entirely among the business interests of Portland, it will be expended in advertising the resources of Oregon, investigating and strengthening existing marketing organizations, land settlement and other state development work.

According to the by-laws of the state chamber, all commercial organizations in good standing are entitled to representation.

VETERAN'S CLAIMS SPEEDILY HANDLED

The Pacific Northwest district, which includes Washington, Oregon and Idaho, is one of the two leaders in the United States in expeditious adjudication of compensation claims, says L. C. Joseph, northwest district manager.

There are 762 disabled war veterans hospitalized in this district at the present time, a slight decrease under the number in hospitals in October. The peak of hospitalization was reached early in the spring of this year.

DATES ANNOUNCED FOR SHORT WINTER COURSE

The bulletin on winter short courses at the Oregon Agricultural college is now off the press, and those interested may obtain copies by writing to the registrar of the college, Corvallis, Oregon.

These courses are arranged to give the largest amount of practical training possible in a short time, and have been arranged to come at a time when the work on the farm is least pressing.

The only admission requirements are that the applicant must be at least 18 years of age, and must have completed the eighth grade of the public schools, or by practical experience have acquired the ability to carry the work successfully.

Courses offered are as follows: Tractor mechanics, January 2 to March 17, 1923; general agriculture, January 2 to March 17; horticulture, January 2 to March 17; dairy herdsman's course, January 2 to June 10; dairy manufacturing, January 2-27 and January 28 to February 24; short course in horticultural products, February 2-24; bee culture, March 19-24.
