**OREGON FIRE RELIEF PAYS LOSSES PROMPTLY**

The Oregon Fire Relief association of McMinnville, represented in this district by B. W. Thorne, is closing its 28th year of business as an Oregon company, having at present \$70,000,000 of insurance on its books, with over a half million dollars of assets, mostly Oregon investments. The company has paid nearly \$2,000,000 in fire losses.

The company is noted for its prompt settlement of losses. Six days after the Astoria fire the company paid 29 policy holders \$41,000. Among recent losses in this locality, covered by policies in this company, are those of Mrs. J. A. Stephens, Corbett high school, Egypt school, B. B. Johnston, and others.

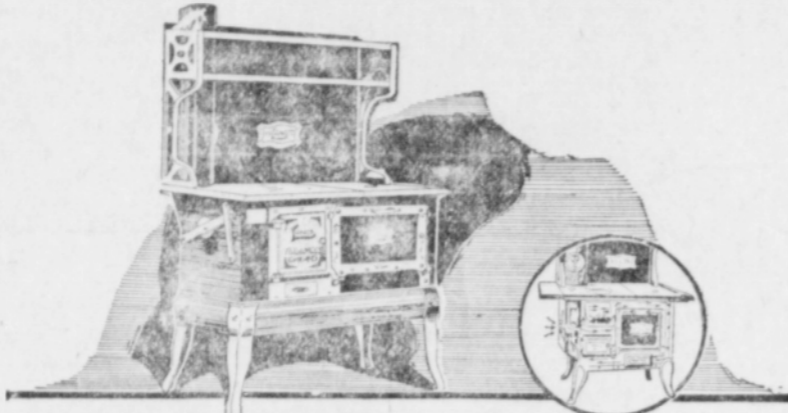

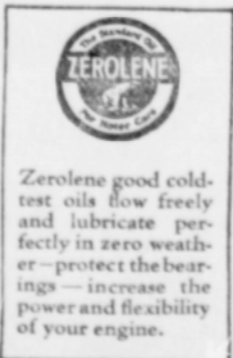
