NEW YORK'S DECISION.

The great state of New York has swung backward to the wet element by repealing its state dry law. The margin favoring that step was very, very small but with a wet governor in Al Smith, a democrat, the wets gained the slight advantage.

This action does not affect national prohibition at all, unless the action of this state be taken as an example and incentive by other states. Indeed, that is the indication now, as it is reported Wisconsin will try out its people on the same question.

It simply means that the enforcement of prohibition in New York state will be in the hands of federal authorities instead of state authorities.

It is a backward step, without doubt, but that is what the liquor element is working for and always has. The friends of righteousness have their faces set toward a better future and are ever seeking to make this old world a cleaner, safer happier place to live in.
