PLEASANT HOME
Walker Proctor, who has operated a general merchandise store at Pleasant Home for the past seven years, has made plans to move his store building and contents, also his residence east of the store to Orient, a distance of about one and a half miles.

PLEASANT HOME (continued)
The work will be done by a Mr. Steiner of Eagle Creek, an experienced house mover. It will require about three weeks to fully complete the work of removing the buildings from one location to the other, although the actual time spent on the road will not be more than a day or two. The store building, about 40 x 60 feet in size, will be placed on rollers which are moved rapidly along the highway. Mr. Proctor expects to conduct his business at Orient along similar lines to those at Pleasant Home. He will locate just across the road and a little east of the new Orient school, on the direct line of the new Mt. Hood loop highway.
