UNITY OF MOTOR LAWS IS SOUGHT

When John B. Reed and Fred J. Elkins, president and manager of the Automobile club of British Columbia, visited Portland and other cities of the Pacific coast last week in the interests of the motoring public, they were on a mission of no little importance to all districts and communities of the western coast country.

It was pointed out by these men during their meeting with the directors of the Oregon State Motor association that there is existing today a variety of signing systems of roads, a variety of opinions as to the proper signals to be given by motorists in the operation of their cars, and in lighting regulations adopted by the various states.

This program is in direct keeping with the effort now being made by the United States highway bureau to standardize all transcontinental highways to simplify the directions to be used throughout the various states for the convenience of the tourists and motorists.

ALL-OREGON EXPOSITION IN PORTLAND, OCT. 5-10

An all-Oregon products exposition will be held in the public auditorium in Portland October 5 to 10. The object is to promote the cause of a unity and beauty in connection with Oregon products and show what the state can do, is doing and the relation of our products to living and industry in general.

It is said every important industry in the state will be represented by displays, among them lumber, milling, furniture, woolen, canneries, dairying, power and light, as well as health and forests.

One feature in connection with this All-Oregon exposition is a prize essay contest by students. The contest will close October 15 and contestants may attend the exposition and gather data for their 800 word essay.

The Economic Importance of Oregon-Made Goods; Oregon's Basic Industries and Their Relation to the Welfare of the State; The Value of a State-Wide Oregon Products Exposition; Art as an Expression of the Characteristic Culture of a State; The Value of an Oriental Art Exhibit to the Pacific Coast.

A complete bibliography has been sent to schools in the state by the Portland public library. The state library also has material compiled on these subjects. At the exposition will be a booth containing material available on the subject.

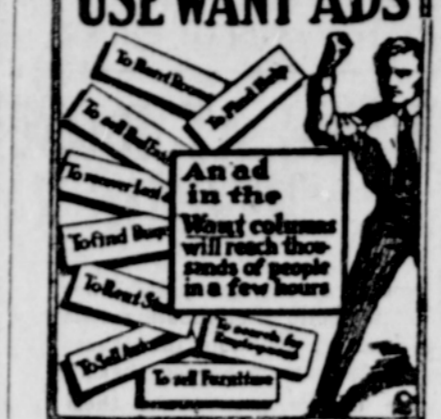
