Gresham People to Spend Christmas Abroad.

Several Gresham people are planning to sail for Europe for a visit of four or five months with relatives and the plan is to arrive at their destinations before Christmas. Miss Gaby VanDoninck, sister of T. VanDoninck, Mr. and Mrs. E. Dhulst and three children will sail from New York on December 12 for Antwerp, Belgium. The former will visit her parents near Antwerp, but before sailing she will visit in Detroit with brothers, August and Alphonse, formerly of Gresham, and two sisters. She has been in this country five years. Mr. and Mrs. Dhulst have been here for a longer time. They will spend a few days in Chicago before sailing. They have been for several years on the Linnemann farm west of Gresham, but their lease has expired and on their return they will look for another location near Gresham. It is possible that Mr. and Mrs. M. Dhulst will also make the trip to Europe.

Bull Run Lake Seepage Checked.

The blanketing work which took place at Bull Run lake during the past summer has become effective, according to the report of Charles E. Oliver, engineer in charge of the development work, who states that the seepage at the lake has been completely checked.

It was necessary to use some water from the lake to help stop the flow, but this has not been necessary since the 25th of September. The moisture at the lake now consists of three inches of snow, with six or seven inches on the nearby hills. The moisture at the lake level has been 1 3/4 inches, of which 9/16 inches has been snow.

Ernest Lehman Hurt in Collision.

Ernest Lehman, residing near Gresham, sustained minor injuries last week when his machine crashed with one driven by Lloyd Sloop, a Boring man, on the highway between Clackamas and Milwaukie. Both men reported the accident separately to the sheriff's office at Oregon City and each driver blamed the other for the mishap. Lehman's machine overturned.
