PEACE WINS A VICTORY.

One of the most momentous steps ever taken by the United States looking toward peace occurred this week when the senate, by an overwhelming majority, assented to this country entering the World Court.

The step taken in the senate is entirely in the interests of peace, and is consistent with the attitude of this country in trying to bring about world peace.

Present plans may be imperfect, but at least a step has been taken in the right direction, and Peace has won a notable victory.

TROUTDALE CELERY LEADS.

In a recent editorial of the Oregon Statesman some interesting facts were gleaned relative to the progress of the celery industry and the outlook for growing this vegetable on a gigantic scale.

When it comes to the raising of celery on a commercial basis, Troutdale, Oregon, has forged to the front and for three successive years has carried off prizes galore as a leading center.

Again the following year Troutdale was heard from in the matter of awards for first-class celery. The growers from this section won first and second prizes at the International Vegetable Growers' exposition held at Buffalo, New York.

Before Troutdale began the raising of celery on the large scale on which it is carried forward at present, the growers had won a gold medal at the San Francisco world's fair in 1915 for the excellency of their product.

While it is true the locality of Salem raises celery in larger quantities than in this section, when it comes to the matter of quality, the Troutdale product is second to none on the market, as their many prize awards will show.
