GRESHAM WOMAN OFFERS FINE BUILDING SITES

A most slightly and attractive area of building sites, together with four modern cottages already on the ground, is that of Waldorf Acres, located about three miles west of Gresham on the Jenne road, which is being put on the market by Mrs. A. M. Allshouse, of this place.

Sixty acres have been platted into tracts in this new suburban district by Mrs. Allshouse, between the Powell Valley road and the Section Line and on the southwest corner of her property she has had erected the four residences, which are so built as to compare favorably with many late houses in Portland's outlying suburbs.
