GRESHAM YOUNG MAN ON 500-MILE HIKE

A most unusual trip is that which has been undertaken by Leslie Judd, 22-year-old son of the Rev. and Mrs. E. G. Judd, who this year graduated from the Milton-Freewater high school.

The boy is making the journey on foot for the first 500 miles, then will proceed by train and boat from the northern border of British Columbia to Fairbanks.

The linemen have constructed cabins at varying intervals along the trail, probably 10 to 15 miles apart, and these are well equipped with provisions, bedding and stoves.

This is one of the longest trails in the world as well as one of the most picturesque. Speaking of the mountains, Leslie says it looks as though all of the snow-capped peaks of the United States were lined up side by side.
