PROSPERITY BECKONS.

Much is said these days about the unsettled condition of Europe and the business prosperity of the United States. The Business Digest, issued by the United States National Bank of Portland presents a view of business conditions for the first six months of the year. It says that America is on the highest plane of living the world has ever known. Summarizing, this article says:

Production and consumption are at fairly high levels. Our people are happy and contented; they are employed and enjoying the sunshine of prosperity as the people of no other nation enjoy. Our financial position is formidable, there being lodged in the United States about 45 per cent of the world's supply of money gold. The tendency toward inflation was checked by a concerted bear movement in the early spring, followed by conservatism of a comforting degree. Confidence, that all-important element in any situation, is everywhere apparent. There is confidence in the federal administration, affairs of the Treasury being admirably managed by Secretary Mellon; bond purchases and savings bank deposits are going steadily forward, and all in all we see no factors over which to be alarmed. We look for a continuation of the orderly readjustment which has been going on for the past several years without either the extremes of optimism or pessimism becoming too apparent.
