Whatever may be said of individuals her and there there is no doubt about the kindness, sympathy and loyalty of the heart of humanity.

As an illustration and confirmation of this fact witness the response made by the multitude of men and women who exerted every effort to locate the lost Jack Strong.

While the number who could penetrate the fastnesses of the west Mt. Hood region was necessarily limited by distance and the ability of the individual to endure the unusual hardship, yet the heart of humanity was deeply moved.

All over the state, as far as the local newspapers circulated and the radio spread its vibrations there was an instant awakening of interest and sympathy.

Several instances have been mentioned to the Outlook of local citizens traveling or on vacation who became instantly the center of an anxious throng when it was known they were acquainted with the child and the location which had swallowed him in its expanse of mystery.

When, in the midst of a thrilling picture at a Portland movie theater, Sunday night, a man stepped onto the stage and announced that Jack had been found alive the crowd arose and nearly lifted the roof with a deafening shout.

There was a response that came from parenthood. Strong men wept and declared they could not sleep for the anxiety that gripped them. They looked at their own children and felt for the suffering parents of the lost boy. Many hastened to offer assistance.

It is doubtful if ever, except in some great national crisis, the heart of humanity was more deeply moved. That it was a child lost made the response the more genuine.

Jack Strong owes his unharmed life to several noteworthy conditions. First of all to a kindly providence for devout persons and church congregations were praying and there was clearly a divine intervention.

Next to that was the boy's natural resourcefulness which his parents had given him a chance to develop. Also his own coolness and the calmness of his parents and brothers. They did not get excited but fought their battle like trained soldiers. They had known trial of a similar kind before.

The fortunate outcome justifies the wisdom of giving a boy a chance to develop his resources of mind and body.
