**STANFIELD'S BOOMERANG.**  
We are amazed at the temerity of Senator Stanfield in bringing about and declaring his candidacy as an independent for the office of United States senator. After running in the primaries last May as a republican and declaring he would not accept the nomination of any other party if defeated, then pledging his support to the republican opponent who fairly defeated him, because the voters had lost confidence in Stanfield, he now repudiates both of his pledges, his party and sacrifices his personal honor and seeks election by the voters of the state to whom he practically says "Elect me or be d—."

If we had personally favored Stanfield in the primaries we would feel that he was not entitled to our confidence now. As it is we are still farther from recommending him for election than we were for nomination.

The Outlook's attitude can be easily explained. We did not oppose Stanfield because we had personally anything against him, nor did we favor Steiwer because the Oregonian espoused him. On the basis of all we had read and heard we drew the conclusion that Stanfield was so near dead politically there was no hope of bringing him back into favor with his constituents sufficiently to insure his nomination as against the field of other candidates of both parties. It seemed wise to concentrate on the man most likely to win, of whom the most and the best could be said.

All Oregon should thank and commend Senator Stanfield for the good work he has done for Oregon. But even that is no reason for supporting him in view of certain derelictions when there are men also capable and in whom the voters have reason to have more confidence.

Mr. Stanfield has now made his own bad case worse by his arbitrariness. He has revealed his own nature and the revelation shows him to be his own worst enemy.

The only thing that would entitle him to any favorable consideration following his defeat in the primaries would be the showing of gross fraud in connection with the election. Such is not shown. It is true there was circulated a few hundred, possibly 2500, illegal recommendations, a so-called yellow ticket, which are thought to have hurt Stanfield. These could not possibly have lost him more than a few hundred votes, if any, and could not account for Steiwer's exceedingly heavy vote over Stanfield, not only in Portland but throughout the state.

And all this talk in a Portland daily about the Oregonian being a dictator in urging Steiwer as against Stanfield is pure political bunk. Might as well say the same about the Outlook or any other or all of the country press which so clearly sensed the real situation in the contest and were generally backers of Steiwer.

The public is warned against admitting unknown itinerant agents. Some are doubtless all right but some are not and it doesn't pay to run the risk. Instances like that which happened to one of our citizens and reported in today's Outlook should be reported to the authorities and an effort made to secure evidence to convict the parties of a misdemeanor.
