STATE PARK VS. NATIONAL PARK.

The Sportsman and Fancier, the outdoor magazine of the northwest, decries the move to urge upon the federal government another portion of Oregon's domain as a national park. The area in question lies in the Cascade mountains east of Silverton and includes the well known and beautiful Silver Falls and other beauty spots of the locality.

The editor of the Sportsman asks: "Why should Oregon or Oregonians want to give away the fairest portions of the state? True, it is, that the area involved, already is in federal hands, as it is a part of the Santiam National Forest, but there is a vast difference between national forest control and national park control. While it is in the national forest, Oregon has a 'color of title' and receives a portion of the proceeds from the sale of timber from it and has complete jurisdiction over wild life, of which there is an abundance in this particular locality. But let it pass to the bureau of national parks and it is as completely lost to the state of Oregon as though it had been ceded to a foreign country.

"If a park at all, let us make it a state park. Without stopping to count the cost and before we realized that we were 'selling our birthright for a mess of pottage,' we surrendered to the federal government vast areas of our choicest lands and today we must beg at the doors of congress for a pittance of that which is rightfully our own. Instead of giving more of it away, let us try and get some of it back. Let us ask congress to cede this particular territory to Oregon for park purposes and then let us set about making it the finest park in the land.

The sovereign state of Oregon has shed its pinafore. It needs no more maternal nursing. It needs nobody to tell it how and when and where to play. It is capable of providing its own recreational facilities for its citizens and its guests."

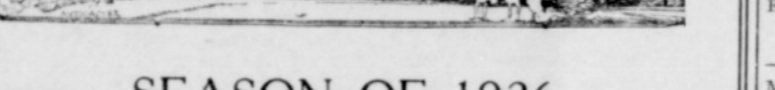
