been talking of the economy of the measure now see that there would be no saving.

Myers sees in the move not only an effort to take over such additional property for taxation as is needed, but a move to take a part of the county and leave the balance unorganized, which would need to be annexed to contiguous counties or be organized into a new and necessarily weak county. The transferring of the records of deeds, alone, would entail a vast amount of work and thousands of dollars of expense.

The real object of the effort, said Myers, is to get the share of motor vehicle taxes which now go to county roads to use in the repair of streets in the city.

O. A. Neal was not entirely opposed to the proposed plan, he said, as he believed that city and county consolidation was sure to come and the question might just as well be faced first as last.
