AN ENORMOUS MISTAKE.

It is hardly thinkable that on the eve of a presidential campaign congress would pass such an enormous appropriation as that proposed for battleship construction.

In fact, it should not be passed at any time. If it passed, and Coolidge approved, it would be in contravention of his avowed policy of economy.

The slogan, "In time of peace prepare for war," is overdue and out of date in these days when there is so much effort to avoid and prevent all wars.

If congress would appropriate a million, or a few million, to encourage amity among nations, study troublesome problems, maintain a commission to promote all that makes for peace, it would act more wisely and the move would react more helpfully on this and other nations than to appropriate millions or billions for tremendous military and naval war equipment.

We need to promote peace. This nation is in a position almost to demand and enforce peace and cease war preparations. All other nations are impoverished. War would be an inexcusable devastation, cruel and wicked.

We appeal strongly to all peace loving American citizens, and that means most everybody, to protest to congress against the voting of hundreds of millions for a war program.

HARPIST FEATURED IN ORCHESTRA PROGRAM

The last of the Portland Symphony orchestra's series of seven popular programs will be presented at the Portland public auditorium tomorrow morning.

This concert will feature the first appearance as soloist, of Ruth Lorraine Close, the internationally known harpist who has been for the last four years a member of the orchestra.

An unusual amount of interest surrounds this appearance, as the combination of orchestra and harp is an uncommonly beautiful one.

Not since Katejan Attl, the distinguished Bohemian harpist appeared with the Portland orchestra several seasons ago, has a harpist been engaged as soloist for its concerts.

The music composed for harp and orchestra is something apart from all other music forms. Its appeal is almost poignant, and the harmonies produced are ethereal in quality.

The program is to include also the popular prelude to act 3 from Wagner's opera, "Lohengrin." This brilliant prelude is perhaps the best-known among all the shorter excerpts from Wagner's operas.

TELEPHONE OPTION SAID NOT ON LOCAL LINE

According to a recent news dispatch in one of the Portland dailies under a San Francisco date line it was stated that W. B. Foshy company, an immense financial corporation, had secured control of large telegraph and telephone utilities in Nevada, California and Oregon, including the Oregon Telephone company which serves the Gresham district with telephone service.

On investigation, however, this rumor is being persistently denied and the report of the sale of the company involving the local telephone service is thought to be in error. It is true that the Foshy company has acquired large holdings along the lines mentioned, viz, the Nevada, California & Oregon Telegraph & Telephone company's interests, but as far as Oregon is concerned, the operations are thought to be confined to Lake county, one of the tier of counties on the southern boundary of the state.

According to the news item which traced down the rumor of the reputed sale of the Coos & Curry Telephone company the Oregon Telephone company or the Montesano Telephone company, no options had been given on them nor is any change in their management contemplated.
