COUNTY BUYS LAND FOR PARK SITE

The tract of land belonging to Mr. and Mrs. Henry A. Latourell on the Columbia River highway, for which the county has been negotiating for more than a year, was acquired by the commissioners for a park site on Wednesday of this week. The tract comprises approximately 70 acres and includes the "figure 8." It is a part of the holdings of the pioneer family for whom the town of Latourell was named.

Negotiations were entered into some time ago with the owners, who held out for \$60,000. Appraisers for the county placed a value of \$20,000 on the property. Failing to come to an agreement the county brought a condemnation suit in circuit court and the case was to have gone to trial yesterday. A compromise was made at the last moment and the Latourells agreed to take \$22,500.
