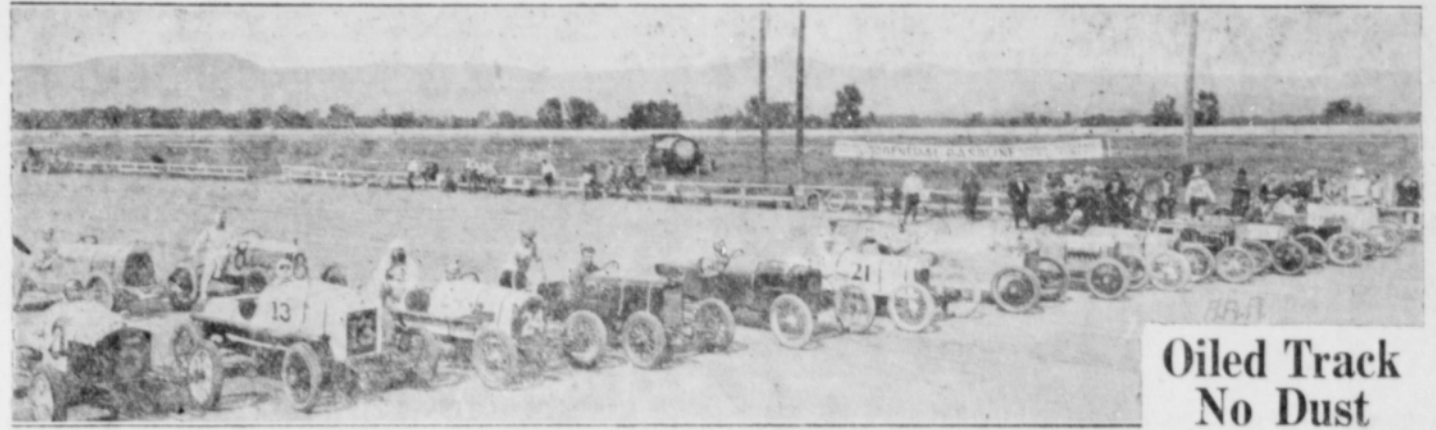

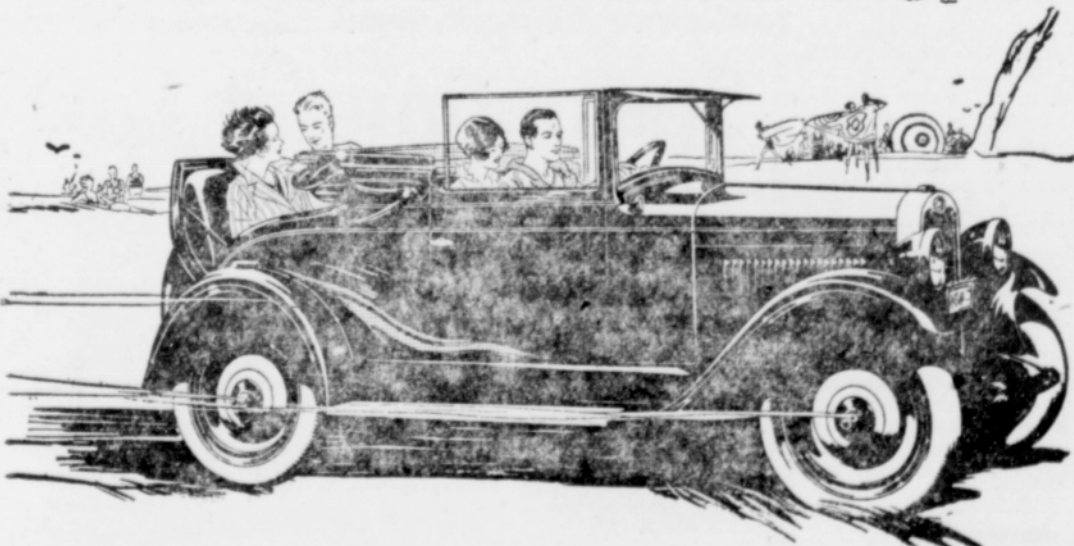

ship training classes, being conducted by the Methodists with the assistance of Professor Andrews of Salem, will be held Thursday evening.

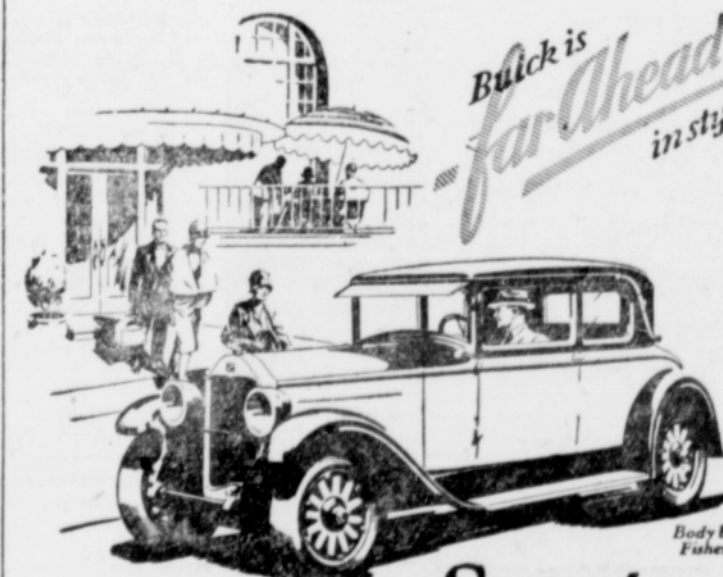

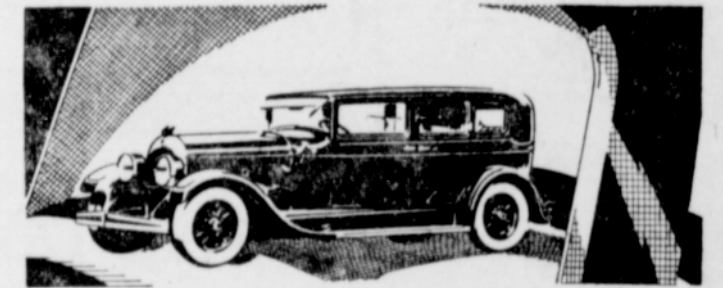
