CAPONS MUCH FAVORED FOR FAMILY TABLE

Increasing interest is being taken in the growing of capons for table use, as the birds are large and the meat of unusually fine flavor.

"A capon is a steer of the poultry flock. Although the contention has been made that an exceptionally large gain in weight follows the operation, it is rather questionable.

"High prices for capon meat should be considered as a possibility rather than expectation. In some places at some times, a high price is paid for capons.

"Only large birds are wanted. In fact 8 to 10 pounds is the usual requirement. This weight demand precludes the possibility of using anything except the heavier breeds.

"Some constructive advertising that will emphasize the meat quality of capons is necessary. The average consumer thinks only of capon meat as something different, in the same way as game birds.

"A second mistake has resulted from classifying capons with turkeys as meat. The longer, slower growing period necessitated by the larger size required demands a higher price per pound to cover the cost of production.

"Cockerels to be caponized should weigh about 1 1/2 pounds and should be eight to twelve weeks of age. Weight is not as important as development.

"The birds should be starved for 24 to 36 hours. In fact, one poultryman maintains that water should also be denied them. He believes that removing water results in less bleeding.

"It is impossible to operate on birds that have not been starved because the distended intestines completely fill the body cavity. There is also greater likelihood of tearing the intestines. Safety requires starving for at least 24 hours.

Switzerland Sardine Sandwiches are usually made with fresh toast bread, but are very good when whole wheat or white bread unwholesed is used.

A Ribbon Sandwich: Cut slices of whole wheat, graham or white bread and butter each slice lightly. On a buttered slice of bread place a strip of canned pimiento, then a slice of Switzerland cheese and on the cheese a layer of chopped water cream which has been mixed lightly with mayonnaise.
