Miss Dorothy Briggs returned home Sunday after attending the big live stock show in Portland.

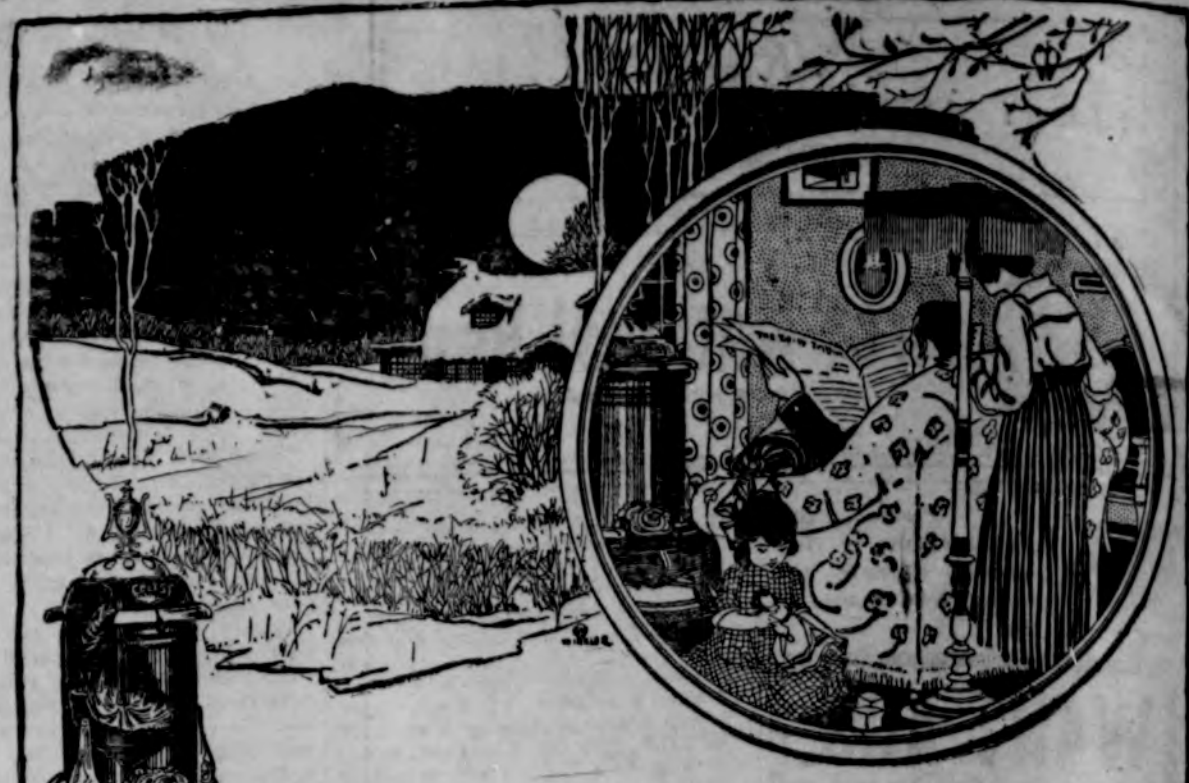
Dr. M. S. Kern and E. B. Aldrich of the East Oregonian made a hurried business trip to Hermiston Monday.
