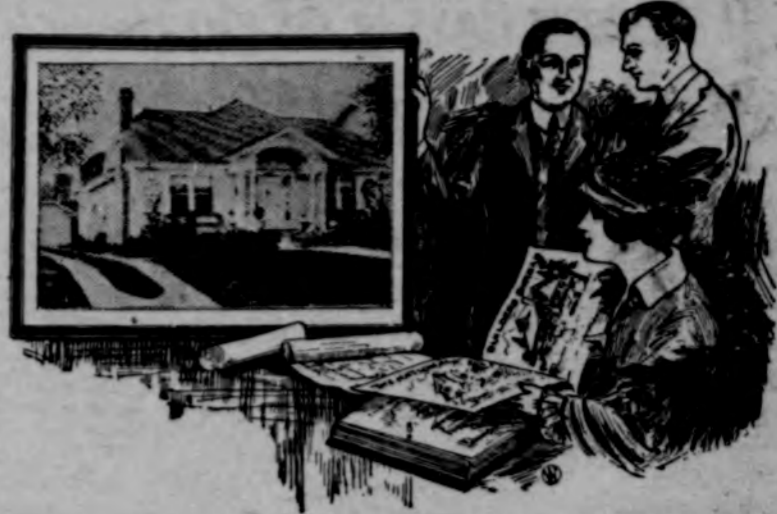
Notice of Sheriff's Sale Under Execution
