Stevenson's Great Story Tells of Pirate Gold in the South Seas; Woman Has Boys' Part

Many theater goers here were thrilled Saturday evening with the picture; "Treasure Island."

Nearly everyone has read this great book and shuddered at the story of pirate gold in the south seas. Readers have been thrilled by the "Pieces of eight," and "Yo-ho and a bottle of rum," even though the bottle of rum itself belongs to history.

The picture followed the line of the story, though some parts were left out, perhaps had to be made the picture conform to reasonable length. It started in an English sea coast town, with the arrival of the ex-pirate Bones at the inn and developed interest rapidly when the pirate crew arrived and try to capture the Flint map of the island where he buried his treasure.

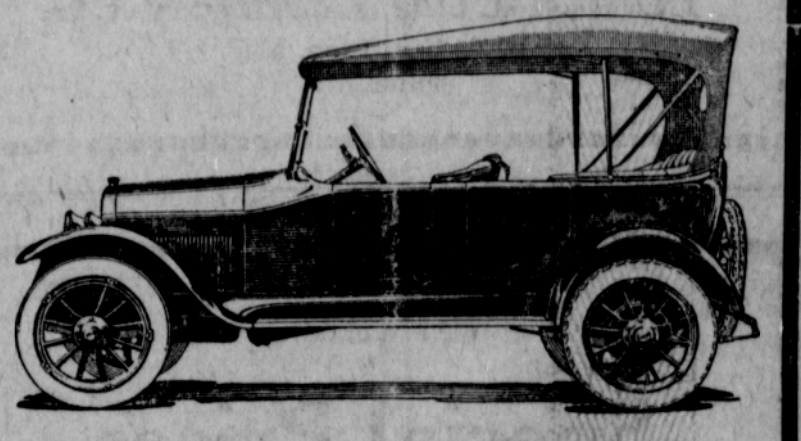
