FARM BUREAU HOLDS BOARDMAN MEETING

HERMISTON MEN ON SPEAKING PROGRAM

L. A. Hunt and H. K. Dean Are Present; Ladies Serve Lunch at Close of Evening

Boardman, Ore., Dec. 8—Following the program announced last week by C. C. Calkins, county agent for Morrow county, a general community meeting in the interests of the Farm Bureau was called at the school auditorium in Boardman Monday night, inaugurating a county-wide campaign to continue through the week.

The meeting was in charge of the local farm bureau and Pres. C. H. Dillabough presided. The state president, Geo. A. Mansfield was unable to be present, and sent in his stead Will Schulmerich, a prominent farmer of Hillsboro. Other visitors in attendance were County Agent Calkins, H. K. Dean, superintendent of the Umatilla Experiment station and his assistant, C. H. Webber, and L. A. Hunt, manager of the Oregon Co-operative Hay Growers.

Mr. Calkins also outlined the plans of the O. A. C. extension division for the coming year and a standing vote

showed unanimous sentiment in favor of Morrow county being included in that program.

H. K. Dean discussed diversified farming and owing to the fact that this section comes forward so early in the spring, he favors the development of early potatoes, melons, and corn for silage and feed.

L. A. Hunt gave definite credit to the farm bureau for the passage of the cooperative marketing bill and the formation of the wheatgrowers and woolgrowers organizations, paying high tribute to the state president, Mr. Mansfield, for his part in securing definite results. Mr. Hunt also discussed the hay market situation describing it as "hand to mouth."
