**CREATION OF IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 8**

"Whereas numerous property owners fronting on Huriburt Avenue between the right-of-way of the O. W. R. & N. Ry. Co. on the west to the intersection of Fourth St. on the east, have petitioned the City Council to make an improvement district embracing the above described street; Now Therefore Be It Resolved, Compliance having been made with the provisions of the City Charter with respect to the creation of an Improvement District, hereby declare that the said Huriburt Avenue from the right-of-way of the O. W. R. & N. Ry. Co. eastward to the intersection of Fourth street on the east, is declared an Improvement District for the purpose of grading, graveling and constructing curbs, same to be standard construction according to specifications and estimates as prepared by the City Engineer; the estimated cost of said work to be approximately \$1.15 per lineal foot for grading and graveling, and approximately 40c per lineal foot for placing of curbs. The said Improvement District shall be known as Improvement District No. 8."
