ORDINANCE No. 113

Fixing Tax Levy For The Year 1924 The City of Hermiston Does Ordain as Follows:

Sec. 1. That there be and hereby is levied upon the taxable property of the City of Hermiston, for the year 1924, a total of Six Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$6625.00) to cover the Budget which was duly adopted by the City Council on September 27, 1923.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Sec. 3. That the City Recorder be, and he hereby is, instructed to mail notice of this tax levy to the County Clerk and the County Assessor of Umatilla County at Pendleton, Oregon, forthwith.
