CITY IRRIGATION WATER ASSESSMENT FOR 1928

District No. 2. Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Ordinance No. 96 of the City of Hermiston an assessment has been levied by the City Council upon the following lots and parcels of land in the irrigation district established by said Ordinance No. 96 for the purpose of collecting a special improvement assessment to pay the cost of water for irrigation and delivery of the same for the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, T. 24 N. R. 23 E. W. M., excepting therefrom Block 7, lots 11 to 16 inclusive in Block 8, Block 11 and lots 4 to 7 inclusive in Block 12 of Newport's Addition to the City of Hermiston, the land embraced in the irrigation assessment district provided for in said Ordinance No. 96 and constructing and maintaining an irrigation system therefor.

The total amount of the assessment in said irrigation district is \$508.83 for cost of water, operation and maintenance.

The contract price to be paid the United States government for water and operation and maintenance for the irrigation in said district is \$302.01.

The assessment is now due and payable at the office of the City Recorder and if not paid by April 10, 1928, the same shall become delinquent and shall bear interest from said date at the legal rate.
