The Tattoo Tracer
A simple tattoo instrument has been devised for marking hogs as they leave the farm for the market so that they can be identified after slaughter. Such identification makes it possible to trace diseased animals to the farm where the infection originated. A tattoo mark properly applied resists all attempts to remove it. Such marks are valuable in establishing ownership of hogs in cooperative shipments as well as in combating disease.

Anemic children need iron-rich foods. Give egg yolk, prunes, raisins, orange juice and green vegetables, especially spinach, as often as possible. Liver has been found especially valuable to persons having such trouble.
