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**ASPARAGUS RIDES HIGH**

The settlement secured on this year's shipments of asparagus by the Umatilla Project Growers' Association from the Three Rivers Growers association which did the marketing job was very satisfactory, according to remarks made by local growers. The price was \$1.45 per 12 pound box to the association. After deductions for handling, brokerage and boxes were made growers still had an average price of \$1.17 per box, or nine and three-fourths cents per pound for the crop.

Not so bad! The men who have gone to the expense of putting in beds and caring for them are feeling pretty good over this year's operations. They are also looking into the future with the expectation of doing better. Practically all of the local beds are young and can not be cut closely. Another year will show a much larger yield than was secured this season, and even if the price should be lower, the added volume is almost sure to bring gross receipts from the spring shoots to a

materially higher total in 1927 than they were this year.

More and more, local people are becoming convinced that asparagus is a mighty satisfactory sideline crop on the project. The satisfaction with the crop undoubtedly will lead to further expansion in acreage next spring.

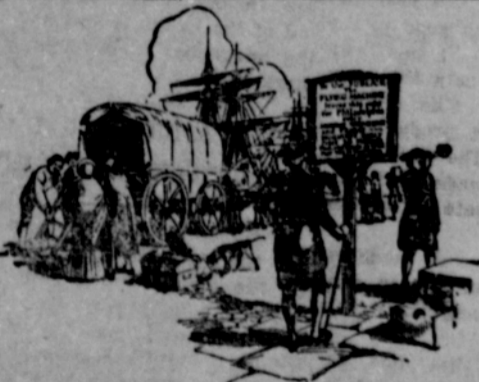
