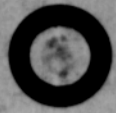


### Progress Takes Time

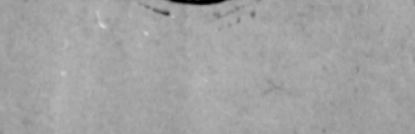
