BLOAT PREVENTATIVE AND TREATMENT TOLD BY JENKINS

In response to requests from cattle owners as to the best methods of preventing and treating cattle for bloat on legume pastures, Assistant County Agent Jenkins made the following suggestions:

"Don't put cattle on pasture until they have had a good fill of hay, or other dry feed. Don't turn them into the pasture when grass is heavy with dew, or after a rain.

"If cattle do bloat the animal affected should be put in a position so the head is higher than the rest of the body. Then use a wooden stick or a cinched up bridle to keep the mouth open. Some dairy men drench with a kerosene-water solution, but formalin drench, a tablespoon of formalin to a quart of water, has some advantages.

"The formalin drench halts fermentation in the stomach and also causes the animal to start belching the accumulated gas."
