MOTORISTS URGED TO SEND IN TRAFFIC REPORT CARDS

Ralph Eggstaff of Bureau of Public Roads Stops Here; Asks Co-operation.

Motorists all over the state are being urged to fill out and mail in the report cards handed them at various points along the road by representatives of the State Bureau of Public Roads, according to Ralph Eggstaff, state traffic supervisor. Mr. Eggstaff was in Hermiston last week.

Motorists in this section of the country are asked to notice particularly the count up that will take place November 27 at the Umatilla County Fair. The cards that are handed out take less than one minute to fill out. They require no postage and are already addressed. No one need disclose his identity on the

cards. The cards are handed out to motorists as a part of a comprehensive study of all federal aid highways in Oregon that was begun September 10, 1929, and will continue for one year.

Information from the cards helps the state officials in solving the following problems: whether to oil or pave a road on which the existing surface is of a low type; whether a gravel surface has reached the limit of its economic use; whether or not the traffic is heavy enough to warrant the removal of snow; problem of traffic regulations and highway safety; whether a highway way should be redesigned near places where there is dense and heavy traffic.
