ultimately completing "series D." "Public sentiment will have to crystallize so that Congress will know whether Oregon and Washington want the comprehensive plan or one of the minor units. If public sentiment supports the recommendations of the engineers then the drive will start for series D.

"Any legislation proposed at the coming Congress authorizing any one of the several plans or "series" will stipulate that there must be contracts for the power—a certain market—before the work of construction starts and enough energy contracted to finance the work as it progresses.

Eventually the sale of power will repay the entire cost of the development irrespective of the immense initial outlay and the government will not be out a cent."
