PRINEVILLE — Irrigation systems were surveyed on the farms of W. F. King of Ochoco and J. Ashbacher, Crooked River, during the past month by W. B. Tucker, county agent, assisted by Arthur King, soils specialist of the state college extension service. Field laterals were also surveyed for Adolph Williams and Harold Meeker of Powell Butte.
