

State Authorities Issue Traffic Control Manual

A model program of traffic safety activities for Oregon communities outlined in a 48-page manual, will be released this week to traffic safety councils and to interested citizens in communities where no councils have yet been organized, through Secretary of State Earl Snell.

The manual, published in cooperation with the national conservation

bureau of the Association of Casualty and Surety Executives, outlines the necessary steps in organizing community safety activities and in making local enforcement effective.

Material dealing directly with Oregon's traffic safety problem is included, Snell said. A similar manual has been used in organization work in the past but it is expected the new booklet will be of even

greater service in guiding the activities and functions of local traffic safety groups, of which there are now more than a score in this state.

This manual, filled with photographs, drawings, diagrams, and lucid text, emphasizes the need for permanent safety organizations equipped to continue the work and to meet new situations as they arise, according to Snell.
