CHRISTMAS SEAL SALE UNDERWAY

Formal endorsement of the 1938 tuberculosis Christmas seal sale was made by Governor Charles H. Martin in a letter to Louis G. Clarke, president of the Oregon tuberculosis association, received Saturday, Mrs. Geo. Harkenrider is local chairman of the drive.

"I am indeed happy to indorse the annual sale of Christmas seals sponsored by the Oregon tuberculosis association," Governor Martin's letter read.

The 1938 Oregon drive against tuberculosis was under way on Thanksgiving day, and will continue until Christmas. This year will mark Oregon's thirty-second annual drive.
