 Feel a bit like God.

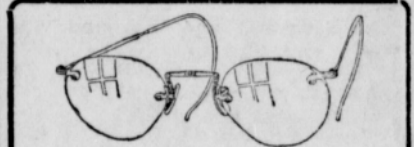
