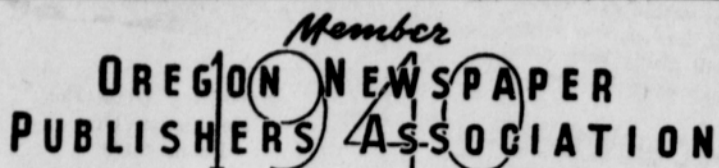

To preserve it we must protect it by constant vigilance.

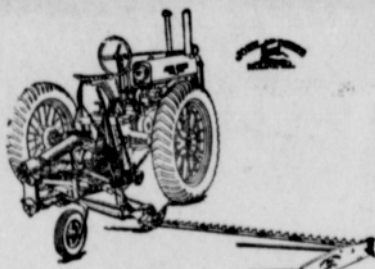
Our honored dead loved America; they died for it. We Americans should love it by living for it gloriously, by upholding its traditions, and defending its principles.

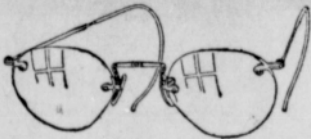
