STANFIELD SECURES VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

The State Board for Vocational Education in Oregon has approved under the National Defense plan, courses for vocational training in the Stanfield schools. Two instructors have been employed, one for work in auto, truck and tractor operation and repairing, and another for general woodworking and repairing.

It is planned at this time to hold evening classes, and young men between the ages of 16 and 25 years are eligible to attend.

Also a plan is possible whereby the men who enroll in the vocational classes may secure employment in similar work during a part of the day and receive pay at the rate of 33 cents per hour for their labor.
